

West Hallam Village Show Rules 2019

All exhibitors must abide by the Show Rules, printed below

- Entry forms for all classes (with entry fees) must be returned by **Saturday 31st August 2019** to **9 The Village, West Hallam, Ilkeston DE7 6GR**
 - Entry fee for all classes: 50p per exhibit
 - All exhibits must be submitted and staged between 5 & 7pm on Friday 6th September 2019, with the exception of bakery classes 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 which should be submitted between 8 & 9am on Show Day
 - All entries must be the work of the exhibitor
 - Children's classes 24 - 25: some parental guidance is accepted, but judging will be based on the child's work; the child's age must appear on the entry form
 - All craft, art and photography exhibits must have been completed within the last three years
 - No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to exhibitors' property
 - The judge's decision is final
 - There is no limit to the number of entries an exhibitor can submit in any one class, but no exhibitor shall receive more than one prize in any one class
 - Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - First prize: £1
 - Second prize: 75p
 - Third prize: 50p
 - All exhibits must remain in the Show until 4.30pm on Show Day
 - **All exhibits must be collected from the Hall on Show Day, not before 4.30pm and not later than 5.30pm.**
- Separate arrangements will be made for those wishing to sell off their exhibits**

West Hallam Village Show Schedule 2019

Fruit & Vegetables:

Class 1: 3 carrots, parsnips or beetroot, of one variety, tops trimmed to about 6"

Class 2: 4 potatoes, of one variety, washed

Class 3: 5 tomatoes, of one variety, with calyx

Class 4: 7 cherry tomatoes, with calyx

Class 5: 6 runner beans

Class 6: 3 apples, of one variety

Class 7: any other vegetable: **judged to equal points**

Class 8: any other fruit, not in schedule, of one variety

NB: fruit & vegetables must be displayed on small paper plates (not provided)

Best in Show (Fruit & Veg): £5 prize sponsored by Paul & Mary Butler

Flowers:

Class 9: 3 blooms of one variety, displayed in a vase (*vase not provided*)

Class 10: mixed vase of flowers (*no additional foliage*)

Bakery:

Class 11: Victoria sandwich, 8" tin, 3 large eggs, raspberry jam filling, caster sugar topping

Class 12: Cherry cake, made to the set recipe with the entry form

Class 13: 4 fruit scones containing any fruit

Class 14: 4 jam tarts using homemade shortcrust pastry; same jam in each

Class 15: Junior bakery – 9 to 14 years – 4 cupcakes - any recipe – showing a variety of decorating techniques

NB: all baked goods must be displayed on a crockery plate (not provided).

Best in Show (Bakery): £5 prize sponsored by West Hallam & District WI

Preserves:

Class 16: a 1lb jar of jam (any variety); *must have cellophane top*

Class 17: a 1lb jar of chutney; *should have metal cap; label must indicate mild/medium/hot*

NB: preserves must be in glass jars and must be labelled, including date when made

Crafts:

Class 18: an item of hand-worked **embroidery**

Class 19: a hand-knitted bag, unlined, for an adult

Class 20: any other hand-made item using **any other craft** (excluding knitting and embroidery)

Best in Show (Crafts): £5 prize sponsored by West Hallam Craft Group

Class 21: a knitted toy

First place toy will be awarded the Sue Ainsworth Memorial Prize:

£5 sponsored by Ann Ainsworth

Art:

Class 22: a piece, any medium, subject: **'Summer'**; maximum size (framed/unframed) 2' x 2'

NB: exhibitors may bring table-top easels to display paintings

Photography:

Class 23: a colour photograph; theme **"Animals in Nature"**.

Open to all ages

NB: only natural photographs will be judged – no Photo-Shop enhancements

NB: photos not to exceed 6" x 8" and to be mounted on card suitable for pinning to a display board; the mount will not be judged

Children:

Class 24: (*10 years and under*) a painted stone;

(no larger than 5"x3"/13cm x8cm approx.)

Class 25: (*10 years and under*): a small plant in a hand decorated plant pot.

Pot not to exceed 8cm diameter by 8cm height (3" by 3")
